

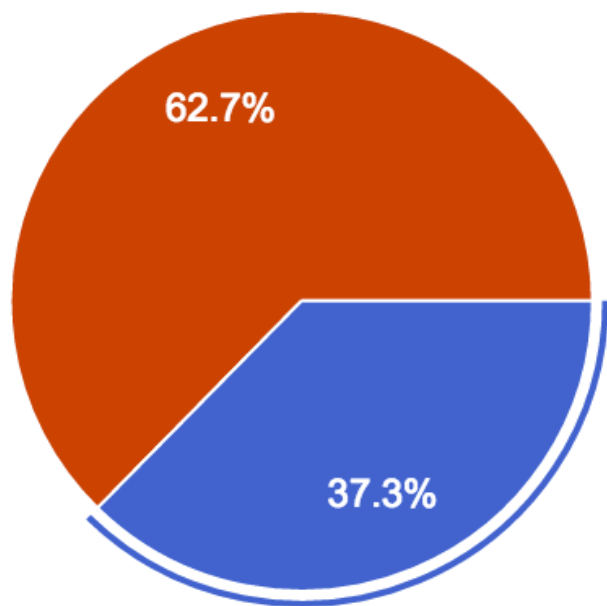


# ISA Members Survey 2016

**Average age: 49.4 years (12.8 SD)**

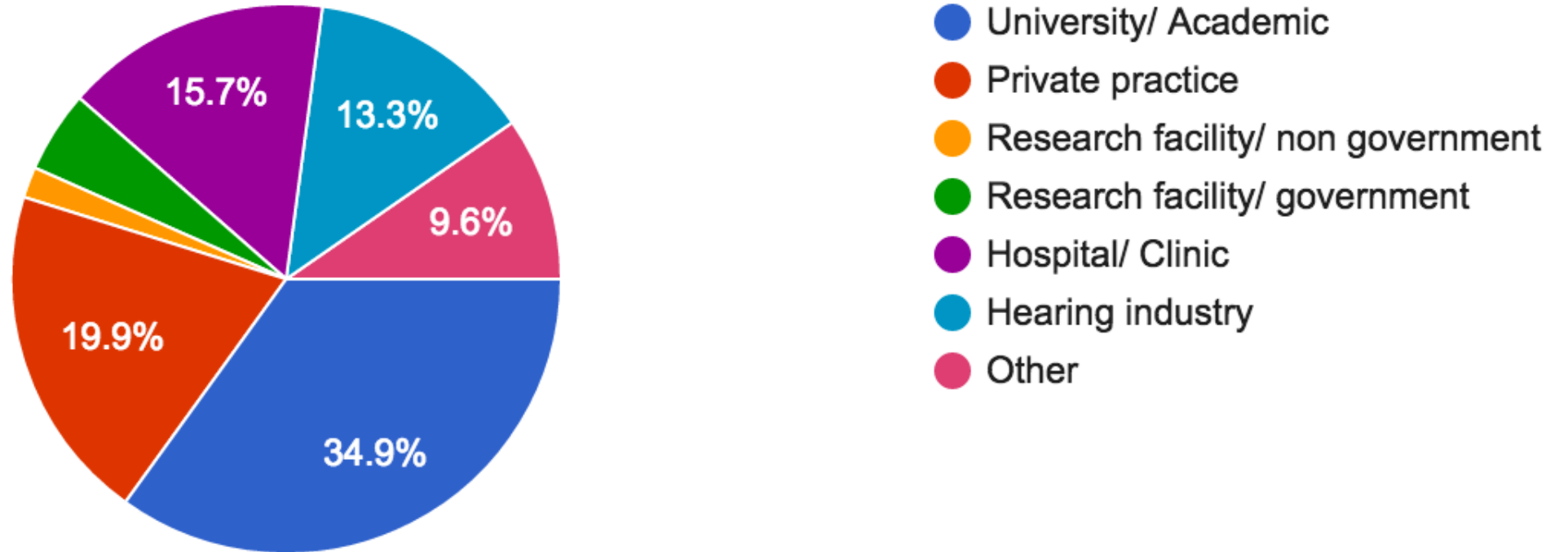
**Years in profession: 23.7 years (12.9 SD)**

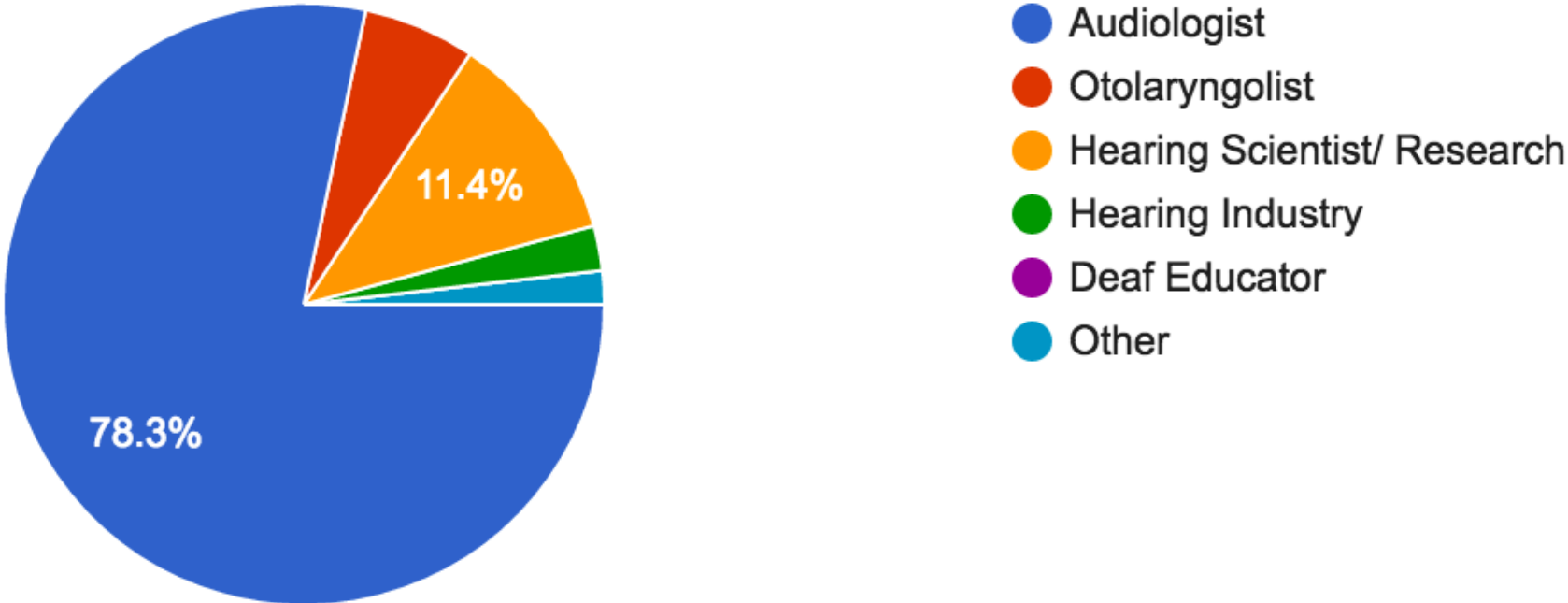


## 7. What is your work setting? (tick one) (166 responses)



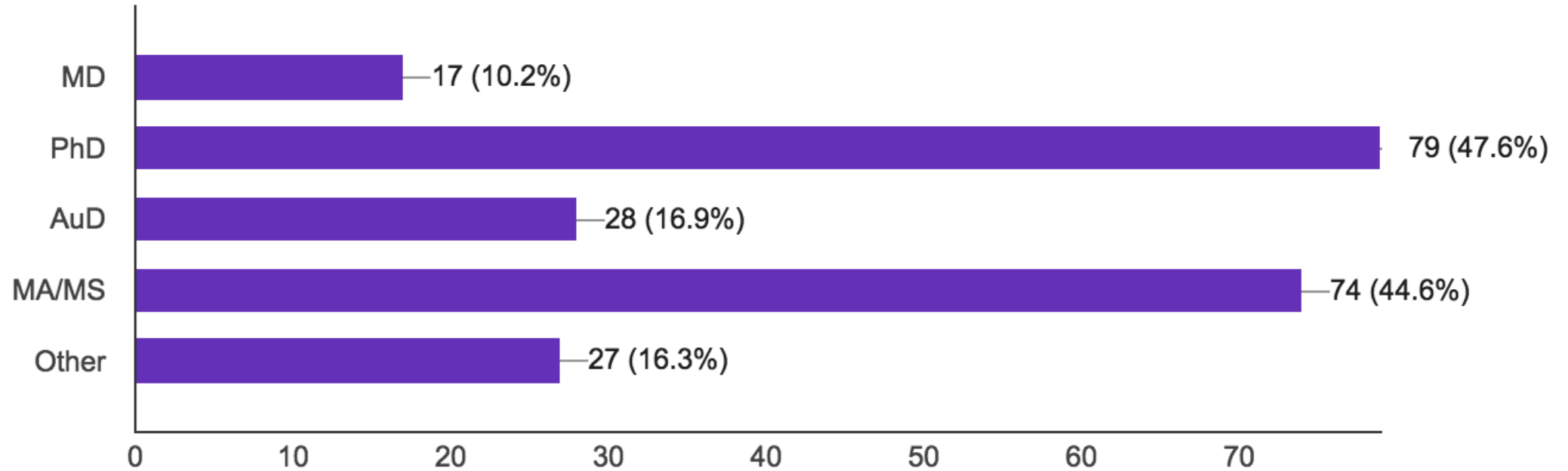
# 6. Which professional area do you consider your primary affiliation? (tick one)

(166 responses)



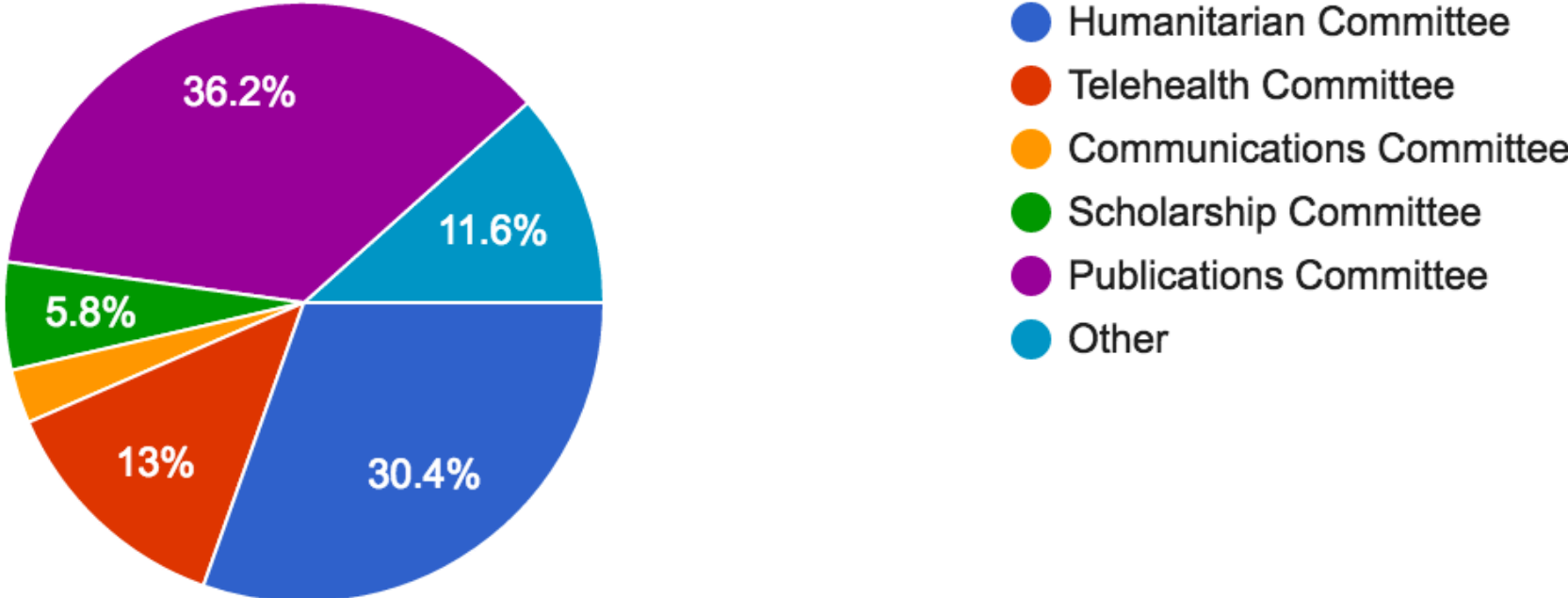
## 5. Which of the following degrees do you hold? (tick all applicable)

# Take Home Messages

- What does ISA represent to members?
  - It is NB to belong to an international society (51.8%)
  - Attracted by IJA (48.2%)
  - Attendance of the WCA (38.6%)
- What does ISA represent to members?
  - ISA is my best option to keep updated with Global Audiology (80.1%)
- If IJA becomes fully OA – will members stay?
  - 85.4% likely to stay (47.6% very likely)
- How do members find out about ISA?
  - Affiliate societies (31.9%)
  - Colleagues (23.3%)

# Take Home Messages

- Why do members access ISA website?
  - Info on upcoming WCA (60.9%)
  - Renew membership (53.3%)
  - Search resources and announcements (53.3%)
- Preferred communication methods with members?
  - Website
  - Mass emails
- Willingness of members to serve on committees?
  - 41.6% willing to serve
  - Publications and Humanitarian top the list
